



Stage Set For Rounds 2 & 3 For The Midwest SnoCross Series

Hartford, WI (January 2nd, 2024) - Rounds 2 and 3 for the Midwest SnoCross Series are set to see the green this coming weekend at the RK Compound in Hartford, Wisconsin. Excitement has been brewing for weeks in anticipation after a fantastic first round in Ironwood, Michigan.

Rounds 2 and 3, which will take place Saturday and Sunday, January 6th and 7th, will see more than 300 riders take on the challenge of the RK Compound. The track, which has been hosting open practices for the last few weeks, will throw challenges at the riders left, right, and center throughout the event.

The pits will open at 9am the Friday before, January 5th, with a practice session being put on, starting at 4pm and running until 7pm. Saturday, the pit gates will open at 6am, with a mandatory drivers meeting at 7:45am in the building, with practice to follow. Saturday's finals are estimated to begin around 2pm, with podium pictures from both rounds 1 and 2 being held after finals. Sunday, the drivers meeting will once again be at 7:45am in the building, with practice and racing to follow.

The RK Compound will be putting on their own Outlaw Race, a knockout style, head-to-head race which will pit the best pro riders versus each other, with \$10,000 Dollars on the line. This race event will take place after Saturday's racing has finished. The Outlaw Race will NOT be a points race for the Midwest SnoCross Series, but regular racing Saturday and Sunday will be.
