

## **Midwest Snocross Set To Start Season**

Ironwood, MI (December 10th, 2023) - The 2023-24 Midwest Snocross Series will begin their 3rd season this coming Sunday, the 17th, in Michigan, at the Mt. Zion Ski Hill. This one day event will run in conjunction with the AMSOIL Championship Snocross Series for an amazing. day. The 26 classes of fury will take to the track for the first time in the new season, for what is expected to be a record-breaking season.

The track, at Mt. Zion Ski Hill, is located right on the campus of Gogebic Community College. The hill, which is open to the public, is known for its numerous "learn to ski and snowboard. programs" for all ages. The track itself is a long one, with many different elevation changes, jumps, and different terrain for riders to maneuver.

The day will start with an 8:00 am mandatory drivers meeting with practice to follow. Racing will

begin immediately after practice, with a stop for lunch break and track grooming at 11:30 am. Racing will resume around 12 pm, with finals estimated to start at 1:30 pm. Racing is estimated.

to end around 4 pm.

There will be no preferred parking at the event. If riders plan on racing with ISOC either Friday or Saturday you will be placed in an open lot by the soccer field or main parking lot. After Saturday night's ISOC race, many haulers will leave the grounds, at that time you may move up

the front parking lot. There will be limited parking at the college for fans they will be running a shuttle bus back and forth from the old Kmart parking lot off US 2 in Ironwood. (1400 E Cloverland Dr, Ironwood, MI 4993)

Riders and pit crews are reminded to have your SmartWaive filled out before arrival to the facility. If you arrive on Friday or Saturday, see one of us for your Sunday tickets and pit passes.

With the drivers automatically paying for the Race Gate everyone will have a packet waiting for them. All the drivers must do is tell us who your pit person is and show that person signed the waiver along with your Smart Waiver or sign a paper waiver. Sunday morning, we will be at the gate.
